START MEETING

READ AND DISCUSS BIBLE

- 1. Read Zechariah 9:9 12, list down the details you can learn about this promised King. How do you think they have been fulfilled in King Jesus?
- 2. The word 'Hosanna', as shouted by the crowds, was both a cry of help 'Please save us', and a shout of rejoicing 'Our saviour has come'. Which posture comes more naturally to you?
- 3. Jesus is the unexpected king (He did not save the Israelites as they expected him to). Have there been moments where Jesus did not meet your expectations? How does remembering that Jesus is our Passover lamb help that?
- 4. Read Isaiah 56:1 9. Who are the people God wants to include? What kind of qualities do these people possess? What are God's promises to them?

 Share if Jesus is the centre of your hopes (you desire more of him), and the anchor of your hopes (you depend on His power. After today's lesson, is God calling you to reset your hopes in any way?
- Jesus condemns the sin of institution over inclusion, and presumption over transformation. How can you (individually or as an LG), put into practice:
 - A) Inclusion over institution
 - B) Transformation over presumption
