#### START MEETING

## **READ AND DISCUSS BIBLE**

- 1. What question did the Pharisees/Herodians ask Jesus? What were they hoping to do through that question to Jesus? (Refer to historical background given by sermon)
- 2. What are some things we "owe to Caesar"? What are some things we "owe to God"? (Read Romans 12:1 2, and Romans 13:1 7)
- 3. The currency & value system of the world is different from that of God. What are some things that may be valuable to the world, but not valuable to God?
- 4. The Sadducees had the thinking that 'this life is all there is'. Is that a way of thinking that you slip into as well? What was the admonishment of Jesus to them? (See Matthew 22:29 - 32)
- 5. Read Romans 8:18 24 together to further understand the hope that Paul is pointing towards. What are some aspects of this resurrection hope you have learnt, and how is it better than this earthly life?
