START MEETING

• Has there been any point in your life when you thought the good news (the gospel) was fake news? Why was that so?

READ AND DISCUSS BIBLE

- 1. What was Peter's charge against Ananias and Sapphira? (See verses 3 to 5) Why do you think it is so serious?
- 2. Why do you think many people who deceive God and the church today do not come to a dramatic end like Ananias or Sapphira? How will the fear of the Lord (Acts 5:11) help your life or the church?
- 3. The angel supernaturally aided the disciples, but the disciples still had to play their part by preaching about Jesus. Why do you think God uses humans to play such a critical role in His mission? (Can refer to Hebrews 1:14; 2:11 -17).
- 4. Read Acts 5:36 39. In what ways do you agree/disagree with Gamaliel's reasoning? Why do you think Christianity has succeeded when other messianic movements failed?
- 5. The Apostles "rejoiced ... and counted themselves worthy of suffering disgrace for Jesus" (Acts 5:41). How can we adopt an attitude like them when we face opposition to our faith?
