




THE TWO AGES





FIVE TEACHING BLOCKS



- 1. Lifestyle of a Disciple in the Kingdom (Chap 5-7)
- 2. Mission of the Kingdom (Chap 10)
- 3. Parables about the Kingdom (Chap 13)
- 4. Community of the Kingdom (Chap 18)
- 5. Future of the Kingdom (Chap 24-25)

BLOCK 1 LIFESTYLE OF A DISCIPLE IN THE KINGDOM MATTHEW 5-7

- Announce the Arrival of the Kingdom
- Jesus has come to restore God's rule over the earth by creating a new family of people called disciples
- Teach them to live as sons and daughters of the Kingdom



BLOCK 2 MISSION OF THE KINGDOM MATTHEW 10

- You have a mission to be a Disciplemaker
- Let them see it, and let them hear it
- Many accepted the offer of the Kingdom, but Israel's leaders rejected Jesus



BLOCK 3 PARABLES ABOUT THE KINGDOM MATTHEW 13

- Jesus changed his teaching style from direct teaching
- Teach in such a way that only those to whom God reveals himself will understand
- God's Kingdom is of ultimate value, and it will not stop spreading despite obstacles



BLOCK 4 COMMUNITY OF THE KINGDOM MATTHEW 18

 Upside down nature of Jesus' Messianic Kingdom – which turns upside down all of our value systems

 Greatness in heaven is measured by child-like dependence on God & not the standard of greatness in the world

BLOCK 5 FUTURE OF THE KINGDOM MATTHEW 24-25

How can you be ready for the King when he gets back?

 Disciples need to stay alert and stay committed to multiplying disciplemakers

Christ's Genealogy | Matthew 1:1-17

START MEETING

- 3. Why do you think some women were named when it was not the Jewish custom to include women's names in genealogies? What do you know about these women?
