## Lesson 11

The Way, The Truth, The Life | Matthew 8:1-34

#### **START MEETING**

- Matthew wrote his Gospel initially for the Christian communities he founded. It is like a manual for new believers. A unique feature of his book is the arrangement of his materials in blocks, the first of which is the so-called Sermon on Mount in chapters 5-7. It seems to me that chapters 8-9 is also a block. Whereas 5-7 is a block of Jesus' teaching, 8-9 is a block of his deeds.
- What is the connection between chapters 5-7 and chapters 8-9?
  Can you find the link-word? That is in fact the key word for the whole section, chapters 5 to 9.
- Chapters 8-9 is a block of 10 miracles. Read through both chapters. Do you see a clear structure? Write an outline if you can.

#### **READ AND DISCUSS BIBLE**

- 1. Give a sub-heading for each the first 3 miracles narrated in Matthew 8. How are they different from each other?
- 2. What is the unit (8:18-22) at the end of the first set of 3 miracles about? How is it tied to the three miracles narrated (8:1-17)?
- 3. How is the 4th miracle in Matthew 8:23-27 different from the first three miracles?

- What difference will the unstoppable authority of Jesus make in your life this week? How is God calling you to believe - to have faith - in Him? What is stopping you that cannot stop Jesus?
- Going further If you have the time, look up the references on discipleship in Matthew other than 8:18-22; and also compare Matthew's records with the other Gospel accounts like Luke's. You will then have a fuller and richer understanding of Jesus' teaching on discipleship.
