START MEETING

READ AND DISCUSS BIBLE

1. Recount the responses of the soldiers and the women at the scene. What strikes you about it? How would you respond if you were present? (no right or wrong answer)
2. While the male disciples had to hide, the women were able to perform the ritual functions of checking on the body. In the process, they were privileged to encounter the empty tomb first. How do you feel as you ponder this? Have you experienced God in unexpected ways in your life?
